Field Events: All field events will be two person relays.
High Jump: - Boys followed by Girls - Boys opening at 5'2" and girls opening at 4'2" - No six jump rule
Long Jump - Boys open pit 9:00-11:00 girls 11:30-1:30 - Warm-up 8:30-9:00; 11:00-11:30
Triple Jump - Girls open pit 9:00-11:00 boys 11:30-1:30 - Warm-up 8:30-9:00; 11:00-11:30
Pole Vault - Girls followed by Boys starting at 9:00 - 30 minute warm-up before start - Girls opening at 7'0" and boys opening at 8'0" - No six jump rule
Shot Put - Division I followed by JV followed by Division II
Discus - Division II followed by JV followed by Division I
Javelin - Division II followed by Division I followed by JV

- 1) Varsity scoring is 10-8-6-4-2-1
- 2) If there is a tie in any field event, the higher place will go to the team with the best individual performance. If there is still a tie, we will use the tie breaker rule for individuals and apply it to the best performance from each team.
- 3) Maximum of 1/4 inch spikes
- 4) Meet will be governed by the Rules of the NJSIAA.

Awards

1. Trophies are given to the team with the most points in each division
6. Medals will be given to members of the first six teams in each division and gender
 - a. Division 1 is made of Group 1 and Group 2 schools
 - b. Division 2 is made of Group 3 and Group 4 schools
3. Six medals will be awarded in freshman and JV events
 - c. There will be no divisions for freshman and JV events
