- 4) Meet will be governed by the Rules of the NJSIAA.

Awards

- 1. Trophies are given to the team with the most points in each division
- 6.Medals will be given to members of the first six teams in each division and gender
 - a. Division 1 is made of Group 1 and Group 2 schools
 - b. Division 2 is made of Group 3 and Group 4 schools
- 3.Six medals will be awarded in freshman and JV events
 - c. There will be no divisions for freshman and JV events
