ELIGIBILITY

The OAT&CCC Indoor State Championship is open only to athletes whose coaches are members of the Ohio Association of Track & Cross Country Coaches.

To be eligible to compete in the OAT&CCC Indoor State Championships all of the following requirements MUST be met by schools, athletes, and coaches:*

- 1. Each competitor is a member of the school team where the athlete is enrolled as a student.
- 2. Each school's team must be approved and recognized by the local Board of Education.
- 3. Each competitor must wear a school-issued uniform. OHSAA uniform rules will be in effect.
- 4. Each competitor must meet all local and OHSAA eligibility requirements.
- 5. Each competitor must have a school coach present at the meet.
- 6. Each coach must be approved and recognized by the local Board of Education **and** be a paid member of the OAT&CCC.

*Failure to meet any of the above requirements will result in the athlete not being permitted to participate.

PERFORMANCE LISTS

Each week, the OAT&CCC Performance List in each division will reflect the TOP 40 athletes or relay teams in each event.

Only marks meeting the following requirements will be included on the performance lists:

- 1. Marks must be obtained while athletes are competing as members of their school team. The school team must be listed as the athlete/relay team's affiliation on the official meet results.
- 2. Marks from athletes or relay teams listed as unattached or with a club affiliation in the official meet results will NOT be accepted.
- 3. Marks will NOT be accepted from meets that don't appear on the list of accepted qualifying meets.

QUALIFYING FOR THE INDOOR STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

- 1. To be eligible for participation in the championship meet, an athlete or relay team must be listed on the **FINAL TOP 40 PERFORMANCE LIST** for each event in which they intend to compete.
- 2. The top 24 athletes or relay teams in each event that declare their intent to compete will be accepted for the meet.
- 3. Each school is limited to 2 entries in any individual event and 1 relay team per relay event.

DECLARATION AND REGISTRATION FOR THE INDOOR STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

- 1. The **FINAL TOP 40 PERFORMANCE LIST** will be released by Monday, March 2 at 9:00 AM.
- 2. To enter the OAT&CCC Indoor State Championship meet, the official coach of the high school team must register all athletes from the list that wish to participate.
- 3. The registration window will remain open from Monday, March 2 at 9:00AM until Tuesday, March 3 at 9:00 AM.
- 4. The list of accepted entries will be posted by Tuesday, March 3 at 6:00 PM.
