

2020 Butler XC Meet - COVID Precautions

- 1. **Temperatures** Teams should follow MSHSAA guidelines and take athletes' temperatures before loading the bus.
- 2. **Tent City** Teams will setup on the practice football field. Please keep your teams in that area as much as possible when they aren't warming up, racing, watching the meet, etc. Please do not set your tents up next to the finish area. Preferably closer to the road on South side or near the bleachers on the East side.
- 3. **Masks** All athletes, coaches and spectators will be asked to wear a mask for the duration of the meet. Exception is for athletes while running.
- **4. Awards** All medals will be handed out in the chute. Plaques will be given to the coaches. No awards ceremony.
- **5. Timing Chips** Normally we clip the timing chips off of shoes in the chute. However, this year coaches will need to collect them at the conclusion of each race and turn them in before they leave. They are not numbered. You just need to turn in the same amount of chips we give you.
- **6. Water** We will not be providing any water to athletes. Please be sure to have your athletes bring their own water bottles.
- **7. Starting Line** Runners should not report to their box until 5 minutes before the start of their race with their masks on. Instructions will be given by the starter, then remove their masks before the starting gun.
- **8. Finish Chute** Our finish chute is limited in size at the finish line due to the chip timing system, but it will immediately turn into a designated area in tent city where they can disperse quickly to their team tent. We also want to avoid a large gathering of fans at the finish line. Please do not set your tents up next to the finish area.
- **9.** Fans There will be no restrictions on fans, but please remind them that masks are strongly encouraged along with social distancing.


