COVID-19 Guidelines: We will be following these guidelines for this year's meet

1. Because we are limited in the number of teams that can compete against each other this year we need to split the teams into two categories – White and Purple. The White Race will have Aquinas, Sparta, and West Salem competing. The Purple Race will have Holmen, Onalaska, and Tomah competing.

2. When you report to the venue you need to go directly to your team camp – there will be sign for each team camp. You will be greeted by a meet worker that will scan your runner's foreheads for their temperatures. Any runner with a temp above 100.4 will not be allowed to participate and must stay in their team camp area.

3. Masks will be required by all people on site. Runners will be allowed to remove their masks for their warm-up, cool down, and for their race. Other than that – masks MUST be worn at all times.

4. Teams will have their own team area. Runners must stay in their team area until they warm up. Immediately after their race the runners need to report back to their team camp – no lingering around the finish area.

- 5. No concessions this year so runners are encouraged to bring their own food and H20.
- 6. No spectators will be allowed for this year's meet. Coaches, managers, and runners only.
- 7. After the Purple Races the times for both races will be combined for individual and team awards. Awards will be delivered to schools

8. There will be a coaches meeting before both groups race to go over further COVID-related instructions
