 - **I will communicate with all coaches via email or text on the day of the race. We will not have an in person coaches meeting**
2. There will be ample parking for buses in the north end of the parking lot..
 3. We will use the bathrooms in the concession stand adjacent to the baseball / softball fields.
 4. One coach should pick up your packet when you arrive. Please make sure your students do not congregate closely in large groups. The starting line will be wide and will allow the students to distance.
 5. We are asking that student-athletes wear a face covering at the starting line and after they finish. Just before the gun goes off they may move the covering down or off.
 6. ***Please remind your Athletic Directors to pay the entry fee of \$125. I understand if the payment is late this year. However, we do not want to lose the invitational for next year if we lose money this year. This payment should be received in a timely manner.***
 7. We do have official bib numbers with pull tags so it is very important we get accurate entries on <https://wi.milesplit.com/>. by NOON of Monday, 21st
 8. SPECTATORS - We would like to encourage Spectators to stay in the outfield of the baseball fields while watching the event.
 9. Medals will be given to the top 3 runners in each grade and each sex. In addition The top 8 remaining individuals based on time will also receive an AT LARGE medal! In addition a plaque will be earned by the First Place team (based on total time) in both the boys and girls varsity races. ALL AWARDS will be delivered or mailed out following the conclusion of the meet.
 10. Results will be posted online at www accuracetimeing.com following completion of the meet.
 11. Teams will be held responsible for cleaning up their camp areas and placing their garbage next to the trash/recycling dumpsters near the practice fields.
