ENTRIES: Three (3) entries per individual event, with the exception of the 3200m run, where two (2) entries will be allowed. One (1) relay team per relay event. 9th & 10th grade competitors only. NO EXCEPTIONS!!

SCRATCH MEETING: We will conduct a scratch/replace meeting at 3:40 in tent located on infield of stadium.

ENTRY PROCEDURES:

The time management of this meet will be provided by K2 Timing.

The deadline for entries is Saturday, May 22nd at 7:00 pm. Please provide an accurate estimate of a time or mark for each athlete.

COVID Protocol:

- Per the WIAA guidelines, masks must be worn upon arrival to the venue and until official warm-ups have started.
 Face coverings are strongly recommended in all settings where people may come in contact with others. Coaches and officials are strongly encouraged to wear masks. Spectators are strongly encouraged to wear masks and practice social distancing guidelines.
- Athletes should provide their own implements or sanitize between throwers and retrieve their own implements after throws. All equipment will be sanitized between participants.
- All schools must provide a tracing sheet and verification form signed by the athletic director acknowledging the forms accuracy.

SPIKES: Spikes may be worn on all runways, approach areas, and the track itself. The tip of the spike should extend no more than 3/16ths of an inch from the sole of the shoe.

SCORING: <u>JV Athletes will be scored together</u>. There will be 8 places scored for all events. (10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1) All events are run as finals, including the sprints and hurdles. "Hundredths" will be used to break ties even by athletes running in different sections.

STARTING HEIGHTS: Pole Vault starts at 3:30pm

- High Jump will be 4'10"(2 in. increments thereafter)
- Pole Vault will be 8'0", 9'0", 9'6", 10'0"......(note 8'6" will be skipped) PV will begin at 3:30pm High jump and pole vault will be conducted as 5 Alive.

SHOT PUT/DISCUS: 4 throws(no finals) These two events will run concurrently in three or four flights

LONG/TRIPLE JUMP: 4 jumps(no finals) The long and triple jumps will be run concurrently with an "open pit" format. Both pits will be open until 6:00pm.

AWARDS: Medals 1-3 place. May be picked up upon completion of meet in the press box.

COACHES MEETING: There will be a coaches meeting at 3:40 in tent on stadium infield.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions will be available

ATHLETIC TRAINER: Will be available on southwest section of stadium for the entire meet.
