COACHES INFORMATION SHEET

- Athletes may participate in a maximum of four (4) events including relays.
- Each athlete will get 6 jumps, 6 throws, and pole vault and high jump will be contested, normally.
- <u>Meet Admission</u>: \$10.00 per athlete, \$7.00 per spectator
- <u>Scoring</u>: The number of teams entered in each division will determine scoring for that division.

# Of Teams 7 or more	<i>Individual Scoring</i> 10-8-6-4-2-1	Relav Scoring $10 - 8 - 6 - 4 - 2 - 1$

- The No False Start Rule <u>will</u> be in effect.
- An automatic timing device will be used in all races. Athletes may be recalled at the start if the timing device does not start!!!
- Athletes are to warm-up in the designated areas only (this area will be discussed at the coaches' meeting). On the first call athletes are to report to the Clerk of the Course. Athletes that do not report will be scratched. On the second call athletes will be released to report to the starting line or exchange zone areas. On the third call athletes are to move on to their assigned positions/lanes on the track. Athletes are to move out of the infield-fenced area at the completion of their event.
- All field events will be held inside the fenced area. NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED INSIDE THE INFIELD FENCED AREA EXCEPT COACHES AND ATHLETES PARTICIPATING AT THAT TIME. ALL COACHES MUST STAY IN THE DESIGNATED COACHES AREA THAT WILL BE SET UP FOR EACH FIELD EVENT LOCATION. AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE FIELD EVENTS, THE INFIELD WILL BE CLEARED OF ALL ATHLETES.
- Each competitor must compete in a proper school issued uniform (Rule 4 3). In relay races each team member shall wear the same color and design school uniform. When other apparel

is worn under the uniform in relays, it shall be of the same color for all teammates choosing to wear them.

- After completing a race, athletes are to exit the track to the left through the chute setup on the football to lead them back to the warmup area. **Please inform them to never walk back across the finish line after they have finished their race!**
- <u>Spikes</u>: 1/4" pyramid or less only! NO CROSS COUNTRY NOR NEEDLE SPIKES ALLOWED!
- Starting Blocks will be provided! Schools will not be allowed to use their own blocks!
- The **home-side stands** will be closed to all teams, only spectators may use. The **visitor-side stands** and designated team camp areas will be denoted on a map.
- Spectators are not allowed, on the visitor's side of the stadium, inside the track areas, nor on the football field.
- Coaches with a team in the relays must turn in a Relay Entry Confirmation Sheet to the clerk of the course. Any changes made during the meet must be made on the confirmation sheet prior to the end of the meet.
- Coaches with vaulters will need to turn in a pole vault verification sheet at event check-in.
- TAPE OR CHALK ARE THE ONLY MARKING MATERIALS PLACED ON THE TRACK, RUNWAYS, OR HIGH JUMP APRON!


