PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS: As per the games committee.

- 1. All National Federation plus NJSIAA rules apply.
- 2. Each school must have a unique and identical uniform for their team members. All athletes must wear a <u>school</u> <u>issued</u> track and field uniform.
- 3. Starting blocks will NOT be provided.
- 4. Only $\frac{1}{4}$ " or $\frac{1}{8}$ " spikes are allowed.
- 5. Only flat soled shoes in shot and discus.
- 6. DO NOT wear spikes in the stands.
- 7. Javelins must conform to the new standards.
- 8. Throwing implements will be weighed prior to each throw at the venue.
- 9. There will be an open pit for the long jump and triple jump during designated times.
- 10. Only officials and athletes actually competing will be permitted in the track enclosure.
- 11. Athletes are to check in at the seeding table once all are checked in that event is closed!
- 12. Please make sure all competitors are on your MileSplit roster and remove any that are beyond the maximum number of entries per team (3 per event). Entry on MileSplit will be open until 12:00 AM on Sunday. May 23

Each LJ/TJ Jumper will get ONE legal attempt measured

<u>Boys</u> (Minimum Measurements: Shot Put: 39' Discus: 105 Javelin: 105') <u>Girls</u> (Minimum Measurements - Shot Put - 27' Discus: 75' Javelin: 75')

All flights will be set up from low seed to high seed. 3 Throws Trials - 3 Finals - Top 7 Moves to Finals - All Ties Move to Finals

Just a reminder

NO RUNBACKS IN THE LJ/TJ/PV&JAVELIN.

<u>The "no run back" rule is definitely in affect during the warmups. What about an "aborted</u> <u>attempt" in javelin, or long-triple, or pole vault during an attempt? The athlete has 1' to complete</u> <u>their attempt. If they abort an attempt they are allowed to 'return to the starting position" and</u> <u>start their attempt within the 1' time limit. How do they return to their starting position? The</u> <u>NFHS suggested common sense prevail - i.e.: they should walk and in the case of the long/triple</u> <u>jump walk along the runway, not on the runway. Pole Vault and javelin common sense prevails. It's</u> <u>not a warning or DQ if they are going back to their starting position after an aborted attempt.</u>
