- No Sunflower seeds
- No Chewing Gum
- No Chewing Tobacco
- No fireworks or open flames
- No Spitting
- No Glass Bottles or Sharp Objects
- No Beverages other than water (if something spills on the field, do not attempt to clean it up - contact an school employee to report a spill)
- No Pets or Farm animals Allowed
- No Bikes, Skateboards, Scooters, Roller Blades or Other Wheeled Vehicles
- No Golfing
- No Climbing or Hanging From Goal Posts or Field Equipment
- No Spikes or Metal Cleats on the Synthetic Field (Rubber Molded Cleats or Sneakers Only
- 1/4" or Shorter Track Spikes Only On the Rubber Track
- Freestanding Markers & Field Equipment Only (No Driving Stakes)
- Please Use Trash Receptacles
- No chairs unless pre approved by maintenance staff.

#### **COVID Considerations**

- Masks are strongly encouraged to be worn outside when athletes and coaches are unable to maintain social distancing.
- If sharing an implement, please disinfect your hands between uses. Sanitizer bottles will be present at each field event, and we strongly encourage athletes to sanitize between attempts.
- Please discourage congregating upon arrival to the field, inside team tents, prior to warm-ups, and immediately following the race/event.
- All athletes and coaches are prohibited from spitting, nose clearing and must cover coughs.
