## Team Entry Fees:

Checks made out to Horizon Christian School. Drop off the day of the event, or mail to the school. No contract required, but please notify Doug Brown (dbrown@structurepoint.com) if your school plans to participate.

- Elementary & Middle School: \$65 per school (or \$10 per runner if less than 6 athletes), covers all elementary and middle schoolers in one combined fee, including boys and girls.
- High School: \$65 per school (or \$10 per runner if less than 6 athletes), covers all high schoolers, including boys and girls.

## Spectator Fee:

- A fee of \$5 per vehicle will be collected at the time of parking for all spectators. Please notify parents and fans of the fee.

## Awards:

Trophy for 1st place team in each race (both boys and girls at all levels).

Medals to top 3 finishers, and ribbons for 4<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup>, both boys and girls.

**Merchandise:**

**Course:**

The course consists of open grass fields and challenging dirt trails through rolling woods. Spikes may be worn. You will be provided with a course map upon team check-in. The course will be marked with cones, flags, and arrows in order to help runners follow the assigned course.

**Notes:**

1. Volunteers: We ask that each school have one or more volunteers to assist as a finish line helper or course marshall in order to fill the specific position during the entirety of the meet (10AM-1PM). Volunteer meeting at 9:30 AM.
2. Schools will be permitted an unlimited number of runners. Elementary runners may “move up” and compete in the Middle School race, but can compete in only one race.
3. For team scoring, we will drop runners from incomplete schools or additional runners past the top seven. The top five runners from each team will count toward team scoring, with the 6th and 7th finishers acting as pushers. Based on the size of participating teams, we may choose to lower the number of runners needed to field a team.
4. Restrooms will be available near the course. Concessions will also be available.
5. Teams may set up camp on the soccer field near the concession stand.
6. Bus/van team parking will be located in the lot adjacent to the pool house and soccer field nearest the course. All other parking will be near the course.
