Zaxby's will sponsor the Collins H. S. Bullskin Relays Track and Field meet scheduled for March 19, 2022. This is a unique early season meet that has been in the planning stages for months. Collins Director of Track and Cross Country George Sanderlin said, "Kentucky does not have any early season relay carnivals. So, we are hosting a track meet with the full array of field events and seven track relays, in addition to both hurdles. We are excited to have Zaxby's as a sponsor since their Shelbyville location on Freedom's Way is only a mile from Collins. They have a lot of experience in helping to promote successful sporting events."

The meet will be unique in that the field events will be staged in the morning ahead of the relays. That way, fans, athletes, and coaches won't have to hustle back and forth between the track and field events. Another thing that will set the meet apart is that t-shirts will be given to the event winners. Zaxby's plans to distribute coupons to all fans and has several other



promotional efforts which will be announced in the future. The meet will be based on the successful Zaxby's Wheeler (H.S. in Marietta, GA) Relays.

There will also be a special award for the winners of both the boys' and girls' 4 X 100 relay - The Avery Farmer Memorial 4 X 100. This event is named in honor of former Collins student Avery Farmer who ran on the Collins 4 X100 and lost his life before he could graduate. The meet will also feature officiating by USA Track & Field certified officials and all new track and field equipment (hurdles, HJ and PV pits / standards, etc.).

The meet is named after Bullskin Creek which runs through the western part of Shelby County near Collins. It will feature local high school teams which have been invited from a radius around Collins.

Field events start at 10:00 AM on March 19th with the relays and hurdles starting at 12:45 PM.
