# Region 7-AAA Track and Field Championships 2022 @ Cherokee Bluff High School Hosted by Cherokee Bluff High School Thursday, April 21 \& Friday, April 22, 2022 

## Entries \& Qualifying:

- 3 individuals open event/gender
- 1 relay per event/gender
- All marks and times should be from the 2022 season--if your athlete/team has not contested the event, he/she/they will be seeded by NT/NM No historical marks will be accepted.
Registration ends on Wednesday, April 20, 2022 at Noon. This is also when the GHSA MIS is due. All entries will be entered into GA MileSplit. Also, you are required to post entries on the GHSA MIS website. Your ADs have that login information.
- 1 for 1 changes will be allowed prior to starting the meet--no re-seeding/re-flighting will occur after the coaches meeting. Once we leave the coaches meeting no changes will be made.
- Field Events/Running Events: The top 4 will qualify to the Sectional B Meet @ Greater Atlanta Christian on Saturday, May $7^{\text {th }}$.


## Field Events:

- Weigh ins will be in front of the track shed for all implements from 8:30-8:50 AM. All throwing implements must be weighed and marked. Competitors may only use marked implements.
- Shot Put, Discus, Long Jump, and Triple Jump--Each school may enter three contestants per event. Each competitor will be allowed three preliminary trials. The top 9 will advance to the finals. In the finals, each qualifier is allowed three additional trials: the best effort can score from the six attempts. The top 4 will qualify to go to the Sectional Meet.
- High Jump--Girls starting height: 4-0; Boys starting height: 5-0; Bar will raise in 2" increments
- Pole Vault--Girls starting height: 6-0; Boys starting height: 8-0 Bar will raise in 6" increments


## Track Events:

- Each school may enter three contestants per event. Races with 3 prelims heats- Top 2 places and next fastest 2 times overall; Race with 2 prelim heats- Top 2 places and next fastest 4 times overall. The top 4 in each event will advance to the Sectional Meet.

- The track will be closed 15 minutes prior to the start of racing. This is to make sure that athletes check in on time and we have time to correct any issues we may have. They may continue warm-ups, just not on the track.


## Event Information:

- PV verification forms due at coaches meeting. Please bring a copy of your GHSA MIS Entries Report to the Coaches Meeting.
- Athletes report to the staging area (start of event) for their particular event (see facility map).
- For relays, please do not use chalk!
- Scoring: will be as follows- the top $\mathbf{8}$ places will score according to GHSA bylaws;

10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1 for individuals and relays.
-There will be a clock near the check in table that will be used as our "track time".

## Rules:

A contestant in Track and Field may compete in a maximum of four (4) events and may not be entered in more than four events, excluding relays. If a contestant is entered in more than the allowable number of events, meet management shall scratch the contestant from the excess event(s) by following the listed Order of Events.

A contestant may officially compete in:

1. Four individual events - NO Relay events.
2. Three individual events - May be listed on any number of relay events but compete in only one relay event.
3. Two individual events - May be listed on any number of relay events but compete in only two relay events.
4. One individual event - May be listed on all three relay events and compete in only three relay events.
5. NO individual events - May be listed on any number of relay events and compete in all four relay events.
Relay teams entered in the Region/Area Meet may list a maximum of eight (8) runners. (a) The relay names remain the SAME throughout the State Meet Series (Region/Area/Sectional/State Meets) and are the ONLY eligible participants for qualifying relay teams throughout the State Meet Series. (b) NO replacements may be made in the Relay list of runners advancing from the Region/Area Meet to the Sectional Meet to the State Meet.

## Awards:

- Team Trophies: Top 2 Girls Teams \& Top 2 Boys Teams;
- Individuals: 1 st, 2 nd $\& 3$ rd place will receive individual medals, $4^{\text {th }}$ place will receive a ribbon.
- Awards will be given on the podium in the in-field after the conclusion of each event. Medals will not be mailed.
- Coaches, tell your athletes to report to the podium after the conclusion of their event if in the top 4.


Facility: 8 lane track, new surface. $1 / 4$ inch pyramid spikes or shorter are to be used on the track.
Meet Admission: Admission cost is $\$ 5$. Coaches must have their GHSA Coaches pass to enter stadium.

Team Parking /Drop Off: You may offload on the west side of the school. Teams must enter through the gate next to the One Bear Nation sponsor board. There is NO PARKING next to the discus area (see stadium map).

Tents: Tents are to be set up in the visitor stands. No tents on the home side.
Athlete Check In: The clerk will be set up in the middle of field. There will be a "First Call", "Second Call", and "Third and Final Call" before each running event.

Meet Results: We will post results on the home side near the concession stand, following each event. Results will be online at the conclusion on ga.milesplit.com courtesy of Runners Fit Race Works.

Infield/Competition Area: Please keep your athletes in designated areas, stands, or warm-up areas. Keep them off the infield unless they are warming up, reporting to the clerk, or to an event to compete. The infield and competition area will be closed to all athletes not running with the exception being the athletes warming up, reporting to the clerk, or to an event to compete. No spectators are allowed in the competition area. No electronic devices allowed in the check-in or competitive area. This will be strictly enforced!

Rules: All GHSA and NFHS rules will be enforced. We will have a games committee to resolve any disputes.

Hospitality: Breakfast and lunch will be served in the hospitality room inside the school.
Athletes are not allowed in the building. This is also where the coach's meeting will take place.
