Athletic Directors please make sure you have all your necessary workers on time and at the meet both days as necessary to cover the events and areas your school is responsible for working.

Each school needs to bring all necessary equipment to run off their field event other than bigger needs. (rakes, broom, pole vault extension bar, curb flags, etc.) Timers need to have a stopwatch. AD's please be present on both days if at all possible as we make up the games committee.

A meal will be provided for coaches and workers in the gym on Tuesday for lunch. Wednesday's coaches and workers meal will be provided by our Booster Club through the concession stand.

AD's, I need a headcount by April 4, from each school, how many coaches and workers you will have working on Tuesday and Wednesday if different so we can be prepared to have you all fed.

With today's technology, we no longer see a need to have a scratch meeting prior to the first day of the meet. All entries will be submitted through Mile Split with seed time and heat and lane by our neutral party responsible for running the FAT system. Any scratches will be made at the scratch meeting on the morning of the 12th. Opening heights will be decided at that time as well.

UIL Rules of Focus:

No cell phone usage or other wireless device used for communication will be allowed on the field or during competition. This includes starting block holders. However, electronic devices may be used in unrestricted areas.

- a. Electronic devices shall not be used to transmit information to the competitor during the race or trial.
- b. Electronic devices shall not be used for any review of an official's decision.

It is illegal to run backward or in the opposite direction (non-legal direction) on a horizontal jump and pole vault runway.
