Event Details for Coaches and Spectators- please read carefully!

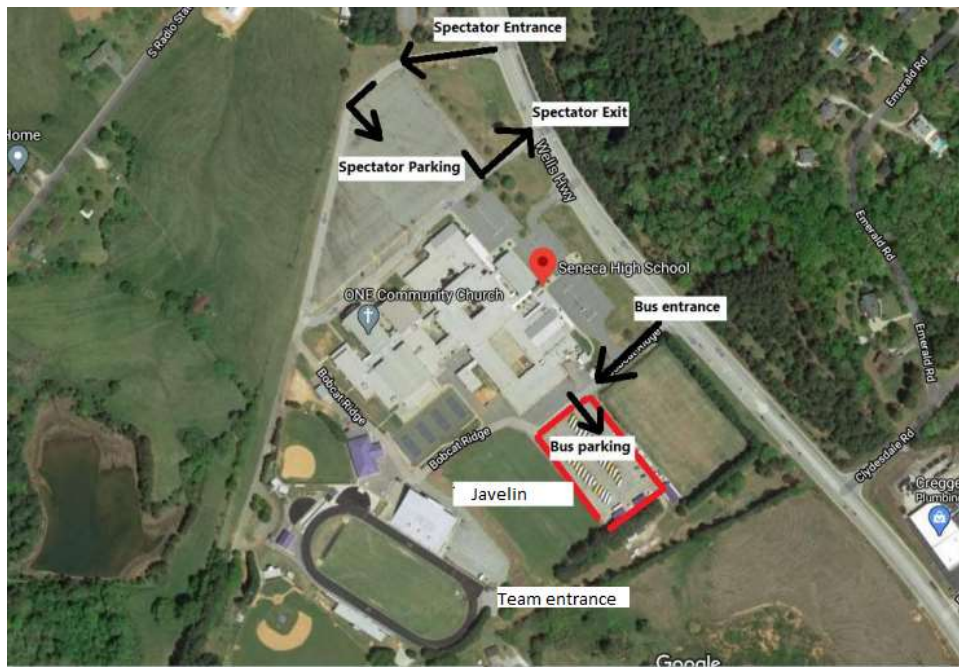
Tickets:

Tickets are available online at <https://tickets.sdoc.org/events/1/seneca-high-school>. There will be a cash box with limited change available as well.

Bus arrival and parking:

Teams that travel in buses will park in the bus parking lot behind the soccer field. Buses will pull into the school at the entrance right next to the soccer field and pull straight into the bus parking lot. You may unload your teams once the bus is parked. Teams may then walk down to the stadium and enter through the gate by the scoreboard end of the field.

Follow the map below to park your buses:

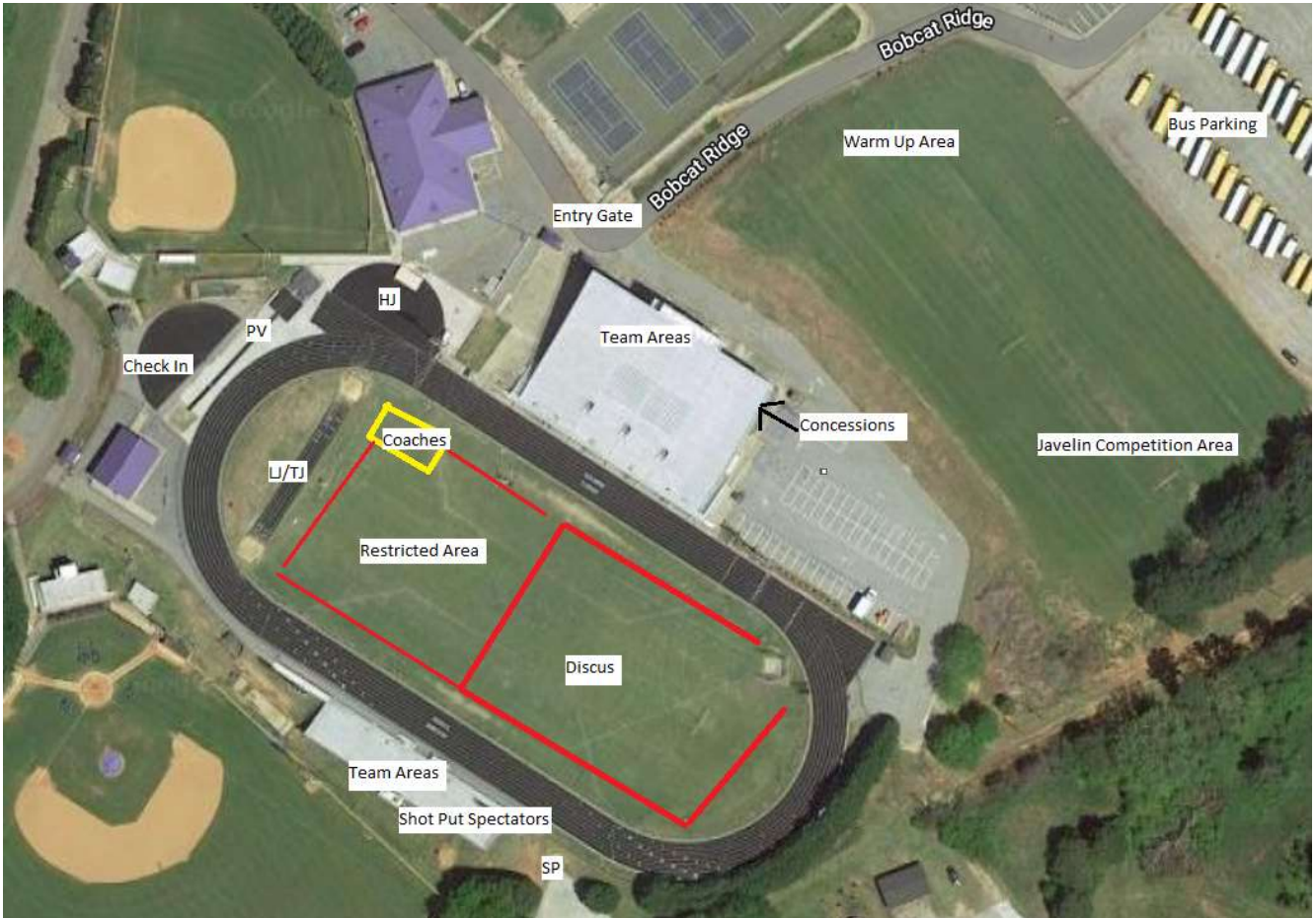


Bus Entrance- Street View:



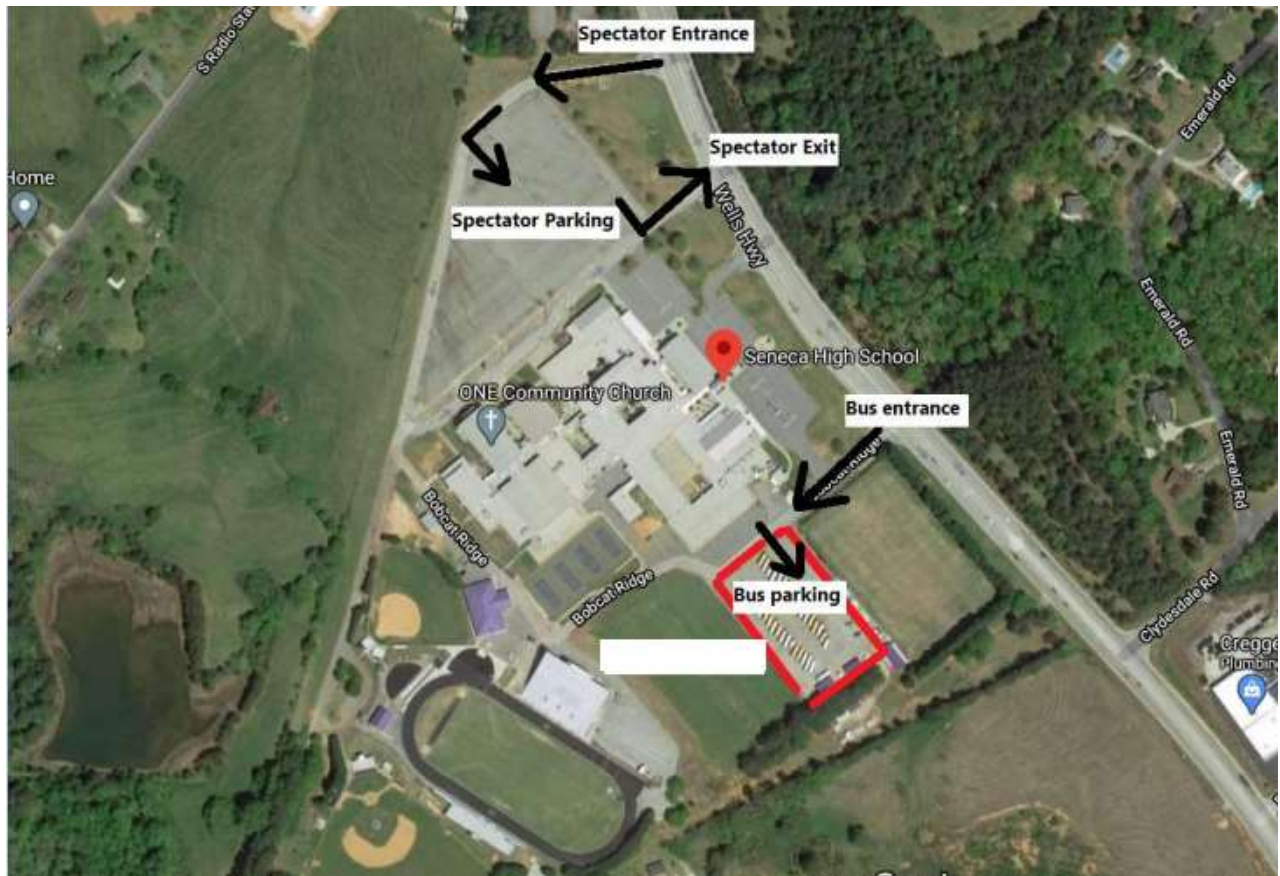
Team Areas and Check-In:

- Teams may set up their areas anywhere in the visitor stands, or in the home stands halfway up or above. **Do not put up tents in the front half of the home stands.**
- Concessions and bathrooms will be open in the home side for spectators and athletes.
- Check-In for all running events will be near the visitor concession stand at the rubberized area. Athletes may NOT enter the track area until the clerk brings them into the competition area.
- When their events are completed, athletes MUST EXIT the track and infield.



Spectator Information:

Spectators and athletes who ride with parents will park in the student parking lot as shown in the map. Spectators will enter through the entrance by the DMV. Follow the arrows on the map to park and exit the parking lot.

Spectator Areas:

Spectators are asked to stay in the spectator areas around the facility, marked in red. Spectators may sit in the home or visitor stands, or you may set up chairs in any of the areas marked in red. The best place to view the shot put is in the visitor stands- you can access this area by walking around the softball end of the facility as marked in red. At no point should any spectators be in the competition areas.
