Qualifying Procedure Region to Lower State

The Top 4 performances from each region automatically qualify for the **Lower State Championships**, plus the next 8 best performances from region 5-8 will also qualify. Max per event at Lower State is 24 athletes/relays.

Qualifying Procedure Lower State to State

The Top 4 performances from Lower State will qualify automatically for the **State Championships**, plus the next 8 best performances from Upper/Lower State will also qualify. Max per event at State is 16 athletes/relays.

Seeding for All Events

100m, 200m, 400m 100/110H, 400H, 4x100 Relay and 4x400 Relay

All laned events will be seeded in 3 heats of 8, slowest to fastest. Seeding will be based on performances from the region meets. All races will be sections by time.

800m, 1600, 4x800 Relay

These races will be seeded in 2 heats of 12, slowest to fastest. Seeding will be based on performances from the region meets. All races will be sections by time.

These races will use a 1-turn stagger start.

3200m

This race will be seeded in 1 heat using a double alley start. Seeding will be based on performance from the region meets.

Horizontal Jumps and Throws

These events will be seeded in 2 flights of 12 athletes, worst to best. Seeding will be based on performances from the region meets. Each athlete will get 3 attempts, then the Top 9 will get 3 additional attempts and will be re-seeded in reserve order.

Vertical Jumps

These events will be seeded in 1 flight of 24 athletes, worst to best. Seeding will be based on performances from the region meets. Opening Height for High Jump will be 2 inches lower than lowest qualifying height or no lower than G 4-0/B 5-6. Opening Height for Pole Vault will be 6 inches lower than the lowest qualifying height or no lower than G 7-0/B 9-0.
