### CENTRAL MAINE LEAGUE TRACK AND FIELD – 2022

- 1. The league will consist of ten teams: Mt Blue, Waterville, Lawrence, Skowhegan, Mount View, Winslow, Madison, Messalonskee, Carrabec, and Warsaw
- 2. Track/Field results for the seeding of meets must be sent to the meet director no later than the Friday before each meet.
- 3. Track teams shall not begin practice before Monday, April 4, 2022.
- 4. Due to the number of schools competing at each meet there shall be a maximum of up to 12 entrants per running event during the regular season and six for field events.
- 5. The host school will have an official serving as meet referee.
- 6. Please contact the host school regarding the pole vault if you have athletes that want to compete.
- 7. Schools conducting meets with less than four teams may add teams to the meet with the prior approval of the other participating schools.
- 8. Host schools must fax or email meet results to participating schools within two days so that teams may record results and school records.

## **Central Maine League Track Rules and Order of Events**

- A) All meets begin at 3:30 PM
- B) Any participant may compete in a maximum of 4 events but one of the four need to be a relay, no more than 3 individual events.

#### **NOTES:**

- 1. Competitors may double up in the 400, 800, and 1600 events. Coaches should use discretion in this decision.
- 2. Each participant is allowed 3 jumps, and 3 throws. All jumps and throws are final.
- 3. Running events take precedent over field events. Athletes must return for their final jump/throw within a reasonable time. High jump bar may be lowered to the point of the competitor's last uncompleted turn.
- 4. One false start rule will apply to all running events.
- 5. A competitor is allowed 3 attempts at any height in the high jump. (maximum)
- 6. Spikes may not be allowed at some facilities. Please contact the school for approval.
- 7. Schools may/may not conduct pole vault at meets or location. (confirm with host school)
- 8. A 400 gram turbo javelin will be used at all meets.
- 9. The host school will provide the shot implement.
