ENTRY LIMITATIONS: 7 & under thru 11-12 divisions – 3 events. 13-14 thru 17-18 enter 4 events. Athletes who are still 18 years of age on the day of the AAU Junior Olympic National Championship Meet shall be eligible to compete in the open division.
