- The "6-6 Rule" is in effect for this meet. This rule requires that all PSAL teams must maintain a minimum of 6 athletes on roster; 6 must compete on the day of a PSAL meet.

- The 55M Hurdles will compete before the High Jump
- Seeded heats will compete last

Field Information:

- Shot put will compete before the weight throw
- The High Jump will compete after the 55M Hurdles
- The first mark for all shot putters, weight throwers, long jumpers and triple jumpers will be recorded. All remaining marks must meet the standard set forth by the games committee. If the marks are less than the standard then the marks will not be measured
- Only pole vaulters who have completed the required amount of clinics (2) may compete in the competition

Award Information:

- Medals will be awarded to the top 6 finishers in all events
- All events will receive a team score
- Team scoring will be conducted on a 10-6-4-3-2-1 points system
- Championship plaques will be awarded to the top 3 teams

- Only pole vaulters who have completed the required amount of clinics (2) may compete in the competition

- All events will receive a team score
- Team scoring will be conducted on a 10- 6-4-3-2-1 points system
- Championship plaques will be awarded to the top 3 teams
