## General Information:

- This meet is for 'Power Rated' teams (teams that scored points in the 2021-2022 PSAL City Championship). These teams are required to compete today and will not be able to compete in the "Team Challenge" on Saturday, December 3.
- Spikes will be allowed at this meet
- Athletes may compete in up to 2 events
- All events will be separated into two divisions, Varsity and freshman.
- All events will follow this order: Freshman then Varsity (if applicable)
- PSAL I.D. numbers are required for this meet. Any athlete that wears any other PSAL I.D number other than their own will have their <u>performances forfeited</u>.

- This meet is mandated but may be included as one of a team's tenmeet PSAL requirement for the 2022-2023 Indoor Track & Field season
- The "6-6 Rule" is in effect for this meet. This rule requires that all PSAL teams must maintain a minimum of 6 athletes on roster; six must compete on the day of a PSAL meet.

- The 55M Hurdles Finals will be conducted directly after the trials
- The 55M Hurdles will compete before the High Jump

### Field Information:

- The Long Jump will compete before the Triple Jump
- The High Jump will compete after the 55M hurdles
- The first mark for all shot putters, weight throwers, long jumpers and triple jumpers will be recorded. All remaining marks must meet the standard set forth by the games committee. If the marks are less than the standard then the marks will not be measured.
- Pole vault competition will take place after the clinic
- In the Pole Vault and High jump, Freshman and Varsity athletes will jump together
- Open pit- The triple jump and long jump will be run as open pits. When the event is called, ALL contestants for the event must sign- in, get their steps. No run-throughs into the pit are permitted. When the pit is closed, the Referee in conjunction with meet management will determine a "time for competition". It is the responsibility of the athlete to take his/her jumps during this time. The athlete must wear their assigned PSAL number and, in the case of the triple jump, tell the event judge which board they will be using. If finals are to be held in these events, the names of the finalists will announced before the finals are conducted.

## Award Information:

- Medals will be awarded to the top (4) freshman finishers and top (5) varsity finishers
- Team scoring will be 10-8-6-4-2-1 in all varsity events. Team awards will be given to the top 3 teams
