- Throws & Horizontal Jumps: 3 attempts- Top 9 to Finals 3 Additional (Prelims open 75 min from Event Start)
- Girls HJ bar opening at 4'0, skipping to 4'4, then increments of 2" until 1 competitor remains.
- Boys HJ Bar Opening at 5'0, skipping to 5'4, then increments of 2" until 1 competitor remains.
- Girl PV bar opening at 6'0 ,skip to 7', then 6" increments until 3 competitors remain, 3" after.
- Boys PV bar opening at 8'0, Skip t then 6" increments until 3 competitors remain, 3" after.
