## **INFORMATION SHEET**

**DATE:** Saturday, March 11, 2023

**SITE:** Ed Boehmke Track and Facility - John Carlisle Stadium – Eastside High School

**Before You Start:** Go to SCRunners and update your roster. Enter you athletes. Make sure that the grade and gender are

correct. AND UPDATE YOUR CONTACT INFORMATION. (On 3rd window when you begin to enter your athletes in a meet - "Edit Contact Information." Check this and scroll down to add and edit who will receive emails, etc. from meets that you use SCRunners to register). We will use the SCRunners Contact

list to send out update information about the meet.

# OF ENTRIES: A limit of 2 athletes per event. You may enter a 3rd athlete per event provided all 3 have met the

qualifying standard listed on the time schedule page. The standard is the best 16th place performance from past meets. SCRunners will only allow two entries. You must send the 3rd athlete to me at <a href="mailto:ehsed1@gmail.com">ehsed1@gmail.com</a> and I will enter him/her provided all 3 have met the standard. You may enter 1 relay team per event. Please be aware that we have minimum standards for marks in the field events. We will mark the first legal throw/jump but will not mark any subsequent attempts unless they are over the

minimum standard. PLEASE ENTER ONLY THOSE THAT CAN BE COMPETITIVE.

**SPECIAL EVENTS:** In an attempt to decrease the number of athletes that compete in the distance races and the number of

heats in the 100, 200, and 400, we will continue with some extra events at the beginning of the meet. We will start at 8:00 with the 4 x 1600 meter relay, followed by the Sprint Medley (or 800 Medley) Relay in which legs of 100-100-200-400 are run, and after the 100 meter trials, the 5000 meters. Please help us by putting some of your athletes in these events instead of the traditional events. All of these events will be

scored and awards presented as with any other event.

**NEW THIS YEAR:** JV events. We will contest a limited number of JV events this year. We want you to be able to run as many

athletes as you can, so take advantage of the SPECIAL EVENTS as listed above, but you also now have the opportunity to enter athletes in a few JV events. There is a limit of **3** per event (but no age/grade limitation) provided you enter 2 in the same varsity event. The 100 meter trials for the JV will be run on the back straight-away while we run the trials in the 100 for the Varsity on the front straight-away. We will also hold the JV 1600, the Shot Put, and Discus simultaneously with the varsity, but at different sectors. (Please remember that this is all tentative to finding enough officials to do both). You can enter your JV's

within the varsity meet entry on scrunners.

**ALSO NEW:** We are adding a varsity 4 x 200 relay. (Our track is finally marked for the 4x2!!!)

**ENTRY:** All entries will be done on-line through MileSplit at <a href="https://www.scrunners.com">www.scrunners.com</a>. All entry performances will be

from previous marks submitted to SCRunners. **DO NOT EMAIL YOUR ENTRIES TO US.** No day of meet registration will take place. **ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED ON-LINE NO LATER THAN 11:00 p.m. ON** 

Monday, March 6, 2023. The online entry will not open until February 1.

**ENTRY FEE:** High school entry fee: \$90 per team\* (\$180 if entering boys and girls) or \$15 per individual.

\*NOTE: A team consists of 8 or more athletes per gender. The fee is an entry fee not a competition fee. No shows are not entitled to a refund. **NO REFUNDS.** Checks can be made payable to: *Eastside High School* and mailed to: **ED BOEHMKE EASTSIDE HIGH 1300 BRUSHY CREEK RD. TAYLORS, SC 29687** 

or brought to the meet.

**TENTATIVE SCHEDULE** – Girls will compete first in all running events followed immediately by the boys. An event will not start

before the scheduled time. We will not get ahead of the scheduled time of the events. If inclement weather approaches we will continue with the meet until conditions cause us to stop. We then may wait to see if the weather will clear or cancel the remainder of the meet. WE WILL ISSUE A FINAL TIME SCHEDULE AFTER ALL HEATS/SECTIONS/FLIGHTS HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED. MAKE SURE TO CHECK THE

SCRUNNERS WEB MEET PAGE FOR THE FINAL TIME SCHEDULE ON FRIDAY BEFORE THE MEET.

**AWARDS:** A special Chick-fil-a medal will be presented to the top 3 individuals and relay team members and ribbons

will be given for places 4-8. These awards will be presented at the conclusion of each event. The top 4 teams will also be presented awards. Scoring will be 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1. All varsity events will be scored.

Awards will be given for all events. An awards presentation will follow each event.

**RESULTS:** Get results for all races at <a href="https://www.scrunners.com">www.scrunners.com</a>. They will be uploaded periodically throughout the meet.

Live results will probably be offered through our timing company - CKET Timing.

**PACKET PICK UP:** Packets can be picked up beginning at 7:15am at the timing trailer.

**PARKING** – Bus parking will be the east side of the school off Brushy Creek Road in our Senior Parking area directly in

front of the school. Please do not park buses anywhere else. We will have a parking attendant at this lot

until 9:00.

ATHLETE/COACH TRACK ENTRANCE - Athlete and coaches entrance will be on the left side of the school through the large gate

to the road to the back of the stadium.

<u>TEAM AREAS</u> Teams may set up camp in the visitor stands, anywhere along the top of the hill surrounding the stadium,

or in the grassy area outside the fence near the start of the 100. You may NOT set up camps in the home stands, at the bottom of the hill near the finish line, on the infield of the track, baseball or softball fields,

or on any paved walking areas.

**SPECTATOR ENTRANCE** - Spectators may park in any lot. Spectators may purchase tickets at one of two gates - at the back of the

school building if they park in the lot on Brushy Creek or at the entrance at the front of the stadium if they

park on the Kimbrell Road side. Ticket prices will be \$8.00.
