TEAM ENTRANCES: Teams may enter the Stadium at Entry A, please refer to the maps on MileSplit Ohio.

BUS & SCHOOL VAN PARKING: Buses & School vans will park behind the visitors bleachers. Buses will enter off Summer Street. Refer to the maps on MileSplit Ohio. School bus and van arrival should follow Route 12(Sandusky Street) East and turn right on Sumner Street then turn right to enter the driveway where signs are posted and parking attendants will direct you into the designated lot.

SPECTATOR PARKING: We will be charging \$5.00 per car.

COACH'S MEETING: 3:30PM @ 50 Yard Line on home field side of stadium.

TEAM CAMPS: Camps will be permitted on the football practice field at the Southeast end of the stadium and behind the visitors bleachers on the North (visitors side) of the stadium.

BULLPEN/CHECK IN: Located near the flagpole.

ATHLETIC TRAINERS: will be available two hours prior to the start of Field Events through the conclusion of the meet. We will have one trainer at the finish line and one trainer near the red barn near the high jump area.

MARKINGS: Tape and chalk permitted for field events. Running events, cut tennis balls only.

SPIKES: ½" or less. Adherents to shoes are prohibited for the shot and discus.

T-SHIRTS: T-shirts will be available for sale on both days, while supplies last.

HIP NUMBERS: We will utilize hip numbers in out of lane races. Numbers will be placed on both hips and left side of chest for these races.

BATONS: Teams must supply their own.

BLOCKS and HOLDERS: We will provide blocks. If you want to bring your own you may. Block holders will not be provided.

SEVERE WEATHER: In the case of thunderstorms or tornadoes: Athletes and coaches will be into the tunnel area located under the home grandstand. Officials will report to the concession stand. Spectators must proceed to their vehicles

AWARDS: Individual awards will be given to the top eight finishers in each event. In case of ties, duplicate awards will be sent later. Top 8 finishers should report to the Awards/Podium Area immediately following the conclusion of their event located at the 50 yard line on the home side of the stadium. TEAM awards will be given to the runner-up and champion teams at the conclusion of the Meet on Friday Evening.

HOSPITALITY ROOM: We have two hospitality rooms available. Please refer to map provided.

WEIGHING IMPLEMENTS: Throwing implements used in the shot and discus must be certified upon arrival. This will take place in the red barn/hospitality room located near the high jump.

*No practicing at any field event until the Officials are present. Per Rule 6-2-6, Field Event venues are closed after the finish of the competition.

STARTING HEIGHTS: (as determined by Games Committee)

Girls Pole Vault 8'0", 8'6", 9'0", 4" increments to conclusion 4'8", 4'10", 1" increments to conclusion

Boys Pole Vault 10'6", 11'6", 12'6", 13'0", 13'4", 4" increments to conclusion

Girls High Jump 4-8", 4'10", 1" increments to conclusion

QUALIFIERS TO STATE: The first four individuals or relay teams in each event in each regional meet will qualify for the State Meet. In addition, the next 2 best times, distances, and heights statewide in each event (field and running) will be invited to the State meet as well. In field events, ties shall be broken by applying the specific procedures outlined in NFHS Track and Field Rule 6-3-2 and 6-3-4.
