2023 AA DISTRICT 6 TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS GENERAL INFORMATION AND MEET RULES

- 1. This is a two day meet that will require trials and finals in all running events except the 800m, 1600m and 3200m run. Please check the time schedule for both days.
- 2. The top 8 times will advance to the finals the next day in all preliminary running events.
- 3. In the shot put, discus, javelin, long jump, and triple jump, there will be three (3) trials. The top nine (9) will advance to the finals for three (3) more attempts.
- 4. Competitors excused to compete in another event will have a maximum of ten (10) minutes from the time they are excused until they must make themselves available for their next trial.
- 5. Spikes must be ¼" or smaller. The clerk and starters will check all spikes. Any individual wearing illegal spikes will be issued a warning and be required to make them legal before competing further. Failure to do so or a second violation will lead to disqualification from the event.

- ALL COACHES AND COMPETITORS MUST STAY OUTSIDE THE FENCE AREA. Competitors
 will warm up off the track. Only those competitors who are in announced events will be allowed
 in the track and field areas. Once a competitor is eliminated, they must leave the track area. One
 (1) coach only is permitted in the designated coaching box area for jumping events.
- 7. Competitors may use their own implements in the throwing events. Weigh-ins for <u>ALL</u> implements will be held prior to the event at a time / place to be announced at the meet.
- 8. Approved footwear for the javelin includes: javelin boots with ¼" spikes, all-purpose shoes, or any other approved footwear that does not include metal cleats or metal tipped cleats.
- 9. Only the starting blocks provided by District 6 may be used.
- 10. A competitor officially becomes a participant when he/she or a relay team of which they are a member reports to the clerk of course or the judge of a field event in which they are entered.
- 11. No marks are to be used on the track or runways. Use <u>tape</u> only.
- 12. Banners, signs, portable radios, stereos, whistles, and noise makers are prohibited.
- 13. Athletes are not to bring cell phones, headphones, or other music/gaming devices inside the fence area.
- 14. Unsportsmanlike and/or unacceptable behavior will be reported to the District 6 Committee and the school's principal.
- 15. Please review the uniform rule with your athletes. Uniforms must be school issued or approved. IT IS STRONGLY ADVISED THAT YOU CONFIRM THAT YOUR RELAY TEAMS ARE IN UNIFORMS THAT <u>ARE EXACT IN EVERY WAY</u> PRIOR TO CHECKING IN FOR THE RELAY EVENTS.
- 16. <u>EACH SCHOOL MUST provide (2) student helpers for a boys AND girls field event</u>. Assignments will be given to you at the coaches meeting.
- 17. Pole vault verification forms should be hand delivered at the weigh-ins. <u>DO NOT MAIL THE</u> <u>FORM.</u>
- 18. National Federation of State High Schools track and field rules will be followed.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

ENTRIES: Make sure you are entering the correct classification – AA, **not AAA**

CONFIRM: – All times / distances must have been achieved during the 2023 outdoor season in a meet officiated by a registered PIAA official. No split times may be used. Indoor season times / distances are not permitted.

Entry is through the MileSplit online entry portal. Access the District 6 AA meet via the calendar option at PennTrackXC.com

EXAMPLE ENTERING TIMES – Athlete runs hand held 11.23 Round to 11.3 Convert to FAT=11.54 You then enter 11.54 **REMEMBER** – You are always adding 0.24 to a hand held time.

PLEASE NOTE:

- 1. Number of entries will be limited to 32 in the track events and 24 in the field events. <u>The</u> <u>exceptions are the 1600m and 3200m run where the field will be limited to the top 20 athletes</u>.
- 2. Please use FAT times when entering. Dual meet times are permitted. Round up hand held times to the nearest tenth then add 0.24. All times and distances must be proven if challenged by another school.
- 3. Scratches are permitted at the coaches meeting before the meet Tuesday.
- 4. Each school is responsible for the correctness of their entries. Correct spelling is the coach's responsibility as the program is generated from this information.

DEADLINE SCHEDULE FOR AA COACHES:

1. SUNDAY, MAY 14th, 12:00 noon

Deadline to enter athletes. You may enter three (3) in individual events and one (1) relay.

2. SUNDAY, MAY 14th, 5:00 pm

After the deadline, coaches can review the acceptance lists on pa.milesplit.com.

<u>NOTE</u>: Pole Vault will <u>BEGIN</u> at 2:30PM.

Note this time schedule change! PV begins 30 minutes BEFORE the rest of the meet! → This schedule is weather dependent and subject to change.

Per District VI Games Committee decision, bungees <u>will not</u> be allowed for warm-ups in the Pole Vault due to safety and time constraints.

AA GIRLS' Pole Vault Time Schedule

Pole Vault Weigh-Ins:1:00 – 2:00 (Located in the Visitor's locker room)Runway Closes/Rules:2:25Competition Begins:2:30

Pole Vault Weight Verification Forms(The same procedure at the state meet)Each team will bring an UNSIGNED weight verification form to weigh-ins.Separate forms for each sex are required.

Only items before weigh-ins on the form:

- 1. School's Name
- 2. Competing Pole Vaulters Names
- 3. Competing Pole Vaulters Grades
- → Only the vaulters from one (1) team and a <u>single</u> coach will be allowed in the locker room at a time. All other teams will wait outside the locker room.

After all of your pole vaulters are weighed in, the <u>HEAD COACH</u> will then list EACH pole EACH vaulter is planning to use based on the individual pole vaulter's weight. The <u>HEAD COACH</u> will then sign the form and present this to the pole inspector out by the pole vault pits.

NOTE:

The **GIRLS** will compete **FIRST**, followed by the **BOYS** 50 minutes <u>after</u> the completion of the girls' event.

Coaches \rightarrow Check the effects on pole vault competitors and other entered events!

Opening Heights AA Meet Using ONE Pole Vault Pit

Girls: 7'3", then 8'0", then 8'6", etc. First run-throughs at 9'0" Boys: 10'3", then 11'0", then 11'6", etc. First run-throughs at 12'0"

Note:The top three (3) placers automatically qualify out of District VI for the state
championship with up to six (6) competitors who meet the state qualifying
standards. PIAA State Qualifying Standards:Girls - 10'6"
Girls - 10'6"Boys - 13'6"
Boys - 12'0"Starting Heights at the PIAA State Meet:Girls - 9'6"Boys - 12'0"
