- Entries: Each School may enter three contestants per event and one per relay for each division. No additions will be made. You may begin scratching or substituting at 9:30 am in the H.S. Commons. If you can get these changed before the day of the better. Each athlete is allowed to enter into four events.
- Schools Entered: Hodgeman County, Ashland, Bucklin, Dodge City Sacred Heart, Grinnell-Wheatland, Healy, Ingalls, Minneola, Ness City, Ness City Sacred Heart, Satanta, South Central, South Gray, Spearville, Victoria, Western Plains
- Qualifications: Each contestant will be allowed three throws or jumps. No finals will be held in the field events. Runners will qualify for the finals in the running events by time. 6 Fastest
- Concessions: A concessions stand will be available.
- Meal: A meal will be provided for coaches and bus drivers in the H.S. Commons.
- Team Camps: We are asking that all teams camp on the outside of the track. We do not want teams to camp on the infield.
- Medals: Medals will be awarded to the top six places in individual and top three relays.
