

# 2025 Track Regional Tournament

Pickerington High School North

Wednesday, May 28th and Friday, May 30th

Start Time: 4:30PM Field Events || 6:00PM Track Events

**Meet Info:** The Pickerington Division 1 Regional Track Meet will take place at Pickerington High School North- 7800 Refugee Rd. The track/stadium is located behind Pickerington North. The auxiliary track will be utilized for warm ups and entry to the throw pit.

**Eligibility and Rules:** Refer to OHSAA website at <http://www.ohsaa.org>. **The team coach or faculty representative must accompany your school's qualifiers.** All OHSAA rules and regulations apply to dress, participation, and conduct.

**Team Camps:** Team camps can be set up on the infield of our auxiliary track or outside the fence closest to Lakeview JH and our baseball fields. **Please do not stake any tents down if you are using the infield of our auxiliary track as your team camp.**

**Complimentary Admissions:** Only those athletes scheduled to compete at the regional tournament and alternates detailed below will be issued complimentary admission. All teams receive admission for one (1) head coach PLUS one (1) additional coach for each specialty area (jumps, PV, sprints/hurdles, distance, throws). Competitors and Coaches according to the following:

All teams receive admission for one (1) head coach <b>plus</b> one (1) additional coach for each specialty area listed below (jumps, pole vault, sprints/hurdles, distance, throws) <u>when their team has entries in the specialty.</u> Maximum six (6) per team

Note: Regardless of the number of complimentary admissions provided, each team will be given access for a maximum of one coach in each coaching box. Coaches in excess of the one allowed will be in violation of the access policy included in the tournament regulations.

Each qualifying relay team will receive FREE admission for six athletes.

Teams must enter through the Team Entrance Gate and pick up your team packet, which will contain wristbands and other information regarding the Regional and State Meets.

**Coaching Boxes:** For field events, coaches should have access to his/her athletes. Coaching boxes will be provided.

**Admission:** Students \$5, Adults \$12. All tickets are purchased online only and handled by the OHSAA. Children age 5 and under will not be charged admission. Tickets can be purchased at <https://ohsaa.org/tickets>. Cash, Card, Contactless payment also accepted on site.

**Inclement Weather:** In the case of inclement weather in which the meet has to be delayed all coaches and athletes should return to their buses. If your bus is not available we will find a safe location for your athletes. All spectators will need to return to their vehicles.

**Available Facilities:** A concession stand serving candy and drinks is available. Food trucks will be on site as well. Indoor restrooms are available. Locker room facilities are not available. Come dressed to participate.

**Recreational Equipment, Pets and Site Regulations:** Recreational equipment such as Frisbees, footballs, etc. will not be permitted at the meet site. No smoking is permitted on school property. **PETS ARE NOT PERMITTED AT REGIONAL SITES!**

**Awards:** All award winners will be recognized over the PA system. Individual awards can be picked up at the Team Entrance gate. Team Awards will be presented to the winning team at the conclusion of the meet.

Team -            Champion and Runner-up  
Individual -    Top 8 finishers in each event

**State Qualifiers:** The first four individuals or relay teams in each event in each Regional Tournament will qualify for the State Tournament competition. In addition, the next two best times, distances and heights statewide in each event (running and field events) will be invited to the state meet.

### **Regional Bibs**

Athletes will be issued a bib number, which is placed on the back of the singlet. The same bib must be worn on both days of competition should the athlete qualify to finals. It is the job of the athlete and the team coach to keep track of and make sure the bib is in place. ***\$20 bib fine/fee for a replacement.***

### **Relay Card/Batons/Blocks**

A completed and coach-signed relay card must be submitted to the Clerk at the time of check in. All team members must be present at the time of check in. Batons will be issued at the start of each race and must be returned. Starting blocks will be provided.

**Relay Markers** - You must provide your own cut tennis balls. Any other form of marking the track is prohibited.

**Appeals Procedure** - If a coach believes a rule has been misapplied or misinterpreted, an appeal may be made to the Head Referee. Such an appeal must be made in writing. An appeal form will be in team packets or at the Finish Timing trailer on the infield. Return the form to the trailer where the Head Referee will be summoned.

**Parking:** All participants and spectators should enter Pickerington North High School facilities from Refugee Road or Ault Rd. ***Spectator parking is available in the Pickerington North High School and Lakeview Junior High parking lots for \$5.00 (cash or card).*** School buses will be directed to park in designated areas near Lakeview JH or Kroger.

The infield must be kept completely clear during the Regional Meet.
