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Boys Schools: Athens, Chillicothe, Dover, Hillsboro, Jackson, Logan, Marietta, Miami Trace, New Philadelphia, Sheridan, Steubenville, Tri-Valley, Warren, Zanesville. Four (4) qualifiers in each event to Pickerington regional.

Girls Schools: Chillicothe, Dover, Logan, Marietta, Miami Trace, New Philadelphia, Sheridan, Steubenville, Tri-Valley, Unioto. Four (4) qualifiers in each event to Pickerington regional.

Time Schedule: See attached sheet. The event schedule will be a rolling schedule on Monday, May 19th, and a time schedule on Thursday, May 22nd.

Uniforms and Numbers: All athletes competing in running events are required to wear a number assigned to them by meet management on the back of their uniform between the shoulder blades. The bib number will be provided on day one of the tournament and **MUST** be worn on both days of the tournament. **The athlete is responsible for wearing the same number on both days. Replacement bibs are available for a \$20 per athlete fee payable to the OHSAA.** New numbers will be issued at each level of the tournament (district, regional, and state).

District Substitution Forms: In the first level of competition a maximum of two eligible athletes may be named on the entry form for each event other than relays. Only one relay team may enter into relay events.

- **Relay Teams:**
 - a. members of a relay team (4,5, 6, 7 or 8) must be designated prior to competing for the first time,
 - b. all members of a relay team must be eligible by the standards and bylaws set forth by the OHSAA,
 - c. coaches will be provided a relay check-in card for each relay team entered – 4x100, 4x200, 4x400 and 4x800,
 - d. the relay team officially becomes an entry when the relay check-in card is handed to the clerk. Once the team is officially entered, there may be no additions, deletions, or changes to the card from that point forward,
 - e. the clerk will check off the four names of the runners who will compete,
 - f. members of a relay team may be changed from the district to the regional meet, providing all other eligibility requirements have been met.

Entries: All entries for Districts must be entered on www.milesplit.com. Entries must be submitted by **Sunday, May 18th at 6:00p.m.** The OHSAA will assess a \$50 fine to any team that does not submit their roster by this deadline.

All scratches/substitutions will be done via Ohio MileSplit where a link will be posted on the Marietta District page to have you fill out. Scratches and substitutions must be submitted by **noon** on the **first day of competition**, so they are due at Noon on Monday, May 19 for any events contested on day 1. Events that are competed on day two are due by Noon on Thursday May 22. Please ensure the changes are clear (i.e. scratch Jane Doe add Jill Doe).

After the noon deadline, the only substitutions permitted will be for those athletes who are injured during the event. For example, if an athlete is injured during the 100m hurdles and cannot compete later in the 300m hurdles, then the coach may substitute but must contact the referee to do so.

The preliminary heat/lane/flight assignments will be posted on MileSplit Sunday evening by 8pm. **This information will not include scratches after the submission deadline and heats may be changed/condensed if scratches merit a fewer number of heats.**

Packets for Coaches: Upon arrival, you will receive your meet packet before you enter the track. All competing athletes and coaches will receive a wristband. These must be always worn to be able to enter the stadium and athlete/coach's areas. Your packet will include: program, relay check-in cards, pole vault certification forms, bibs and safety pins, and regional meet information. A second wristband will be issued on day 2 along with a finals meet program.

Athlete Check-in Area: Check in for field events will be done at the field event area. Hip numbers are required for all running events. Checking in for a running event is a two-step process. The first step is getting picking up a hip number from the table that will be located outside the gate of the 100m dash starting line. The second step is checking with the clerk who will be located near the hip number table.

Starting Blocks: Please feel free to bring your own set of blocks. The spikes in the blocks are to be ¼ inch pyramid spikes. Starting blocks that are not provided by the meet management needs to be check and cleared by the head starter.

Gates: Teams will be permitted in the facility an hour and a half prior to the competition (2:30 PM both days). Spectator gates will open one hour prior to the competition. The gates closest to the finish line will be for exiting the track after events. All competitors are to enter at the start of the 100m dash and exit the track from the gate closest to the finish line.

Team Camp Site: Tents can be set up in the grass football field to the right of the track where teams enter. This may change if that area is muddy and/or it is raining. If it is raining and muddy, then tents may be set up on the outer fence or the visitor's bleachers. Tents may not be set up along the fence that surrounds the track or in the home bleachers.

Scoring: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1

Other Information: All coaches must remain out of the timing and judging areas. **The infield area will be prohibited. Coaches and athletes will not be permitted to stand or sit in prohibited areas.** Coaches are permitted to confer with their long jump, high jump, and pole vault athletes in the designated coaching boxes that will be flagged off. Coaches must stay in the coaches boxes/area while at high jump and pole vault. Coaches' boxes will be painted or flagged off in the shot and discus areas for coaches to confer with their athletes during their flights.

Admission fee for spectators and fans is \$8.00. Admission fee for students is \$5.00. Kids under the age of 6 are free. Tickets can be purchased online at <https://www.ohsaa.org/tickets>. Cash tickets will be sold at the gate.
