

We will be bringing back Old Timers Timing, Lisa and Randy Lee, to handle our timing system. There will be live results as well. You will enter your athletes on MileSplit. All participating teams should have received an invite, if not please email Coach Peteet (enpeteet@alvaradoisd.net) or Coach Cruz (cruz@alvaradoisd.net). All athletes' information will need to be submitted by Midnight Tuesday, February 24th. Please understand that the scratch meeting will be for scratching athletes only and not to add or replace. The scratch meeting will be held in the field house at 7:45 am.

General Information

- 
1. Medals will be awarded to 1st-3rd place in each event for each division. A plaque will be awarded to the 1st place team in each division and relay batons will be awarded to 1st place relay teams.
  2. Athletes need to come dressed to compete. There will not be any dressing facilities available besides restrooms.
  3. ONLY participants will warm up in the middle of the field, all other athletes are able to spectate from the home side stands. Please tell all athletes and spectators to stay off the railings in stands so everyone will be able to see the events. All contestants and coaches must stay away from the finish line when not competing. NO PARENTS OR NON-SCHOOL COACHES ARE ALLOWED ON THE INFIELD. Parents will enter and spectate on the Home side stands.
  4. All Teams will need to be set up on the visitors side. A map is provided.
  5. Please have your athletes clean their camp sites prior to leaving the meet.
  6. Results and awards will be provided at the conclusion.
  7. Breakfast and lunch will be provided for coaches. Soda and water will be supplied for coaches in the field house. Please note that only water is allowed on the field and track areas.
  8. We will NOT have meal tickets for athletes. Concession stands will be available for the general public and athletes on the home side.

**Bus Parking-** Please use the visitor parking lot for unloading/loading.

A labeled map will be included.

**Athletic Training/Water-** There will be water stations set up throughout the field and warm up areas.

We will have a trainer station set up outside of the locker rooms on the south end of the stadium.

**Field Events-** Field events warmups should take place at their sites. Field

Event check-in should start no later than **7:35** and roll by **7:55**.

If a division finishes early, we will move on. If athletes are competing in multiple field events, they should communicate with the coaches running off the event. As soon as they finish with one, they should go to the next one.

Pole Vault and High Jump take priority.

-Long/Triple Jump- 3 Jumps. We would like to stick to the No Runback Rule. Please have marks set prior.

-Shotput/Discus- 3 Throws. Would like for each thrower to take their The first 2 throw's the first time up. Can take all 3.

**Team Camps-** All camps should be set up in the visitor side bleachers or the grass areas around them.

**Relays-** Small "international" is the beginning of the exchange zone.

We will provide a color chart.

**Race Check-in-** Check-in will be at the start/finish line. Runners will be walked over to their starting areas.
