The annual Coldwater Lions' Invitational will be held at Coldwater on Saturday, October 4, beginning at 9 a.m. Come to Cavalier Stadium for your packet in the white building (CAV building) located on the northwest corner of the stadium. 1-15 – Junior High Boys and Girls – Medals
16-50 – Junior High Boys and Girls – Ribbons

COURSE: Basically flat and grassy except for the 300 meters on the track.

CONCESSIONS AND T-SHIRTS WILL BE AVAILABLE.

Couple of Race Day Notes:

1. Buses may park in the west side of the stadium parking or the swimming pool parking lot on Vine Street. Coaches may pick up their packets at the west entrance to the stadium. We will have someone handing them to you as you arrive.
2. Camps may be made in the park which is on the west side of the stadium. Just please pay attention to the course itself.
3. Runners need to report 10 minutes prior to race time.

***ATHLETE NUMBERS & TIMING CHIPS :

4. We will be using a finish chip system.

→ CHIPS: We are using disposable chips that are attached to the backside of their bibs. We simply ask that athletes clearly and securely have their bib attached to the front of their jersey.

5. Mile and 2-mile times will be shouted out at each point.
6. Runners will be disqualified for cutting the course, flipping the flags, and wearing anything over 1/4" spikes
7. Results should be available on Ohio Mile Split shortly after the completion of each race.

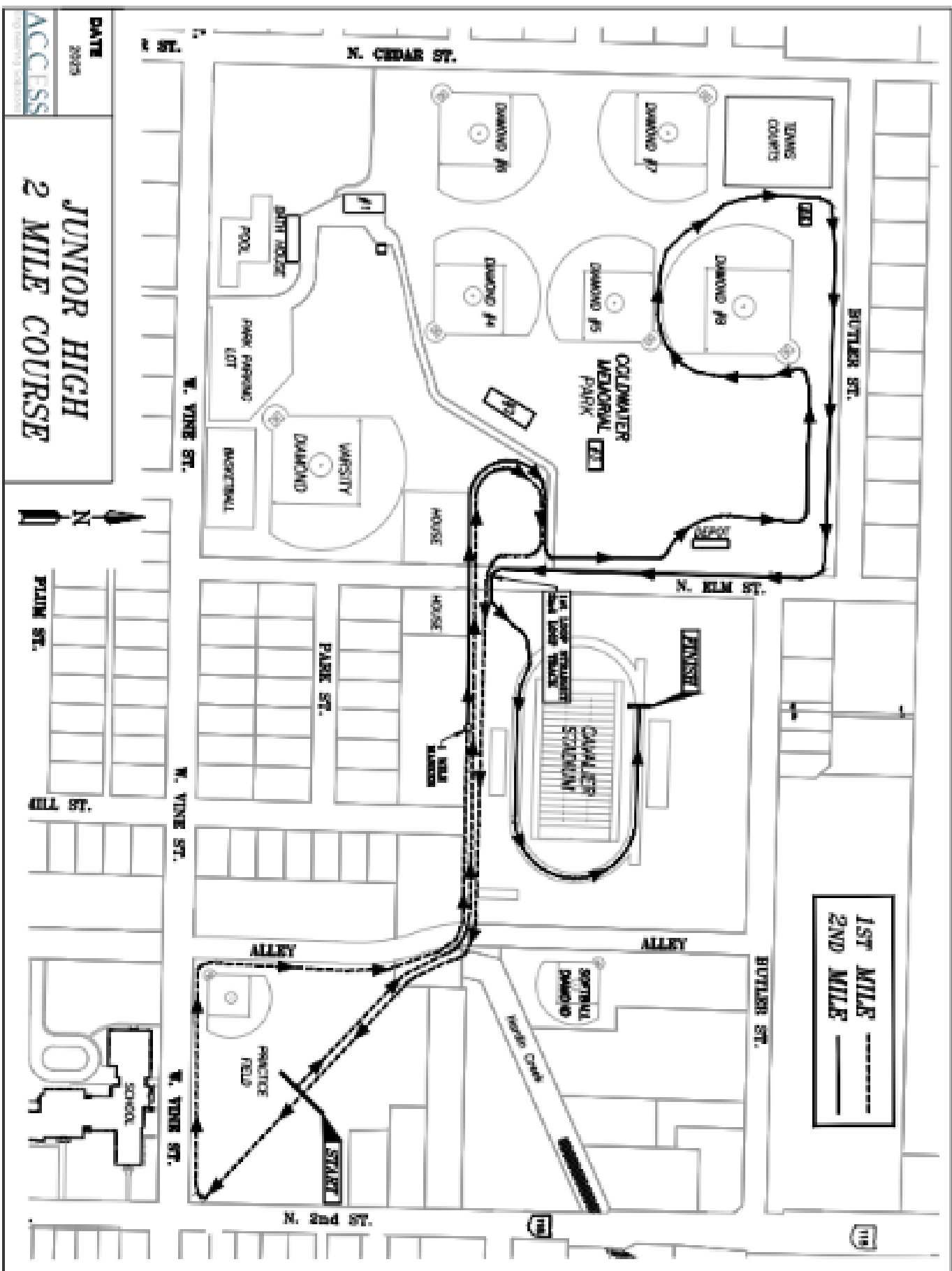

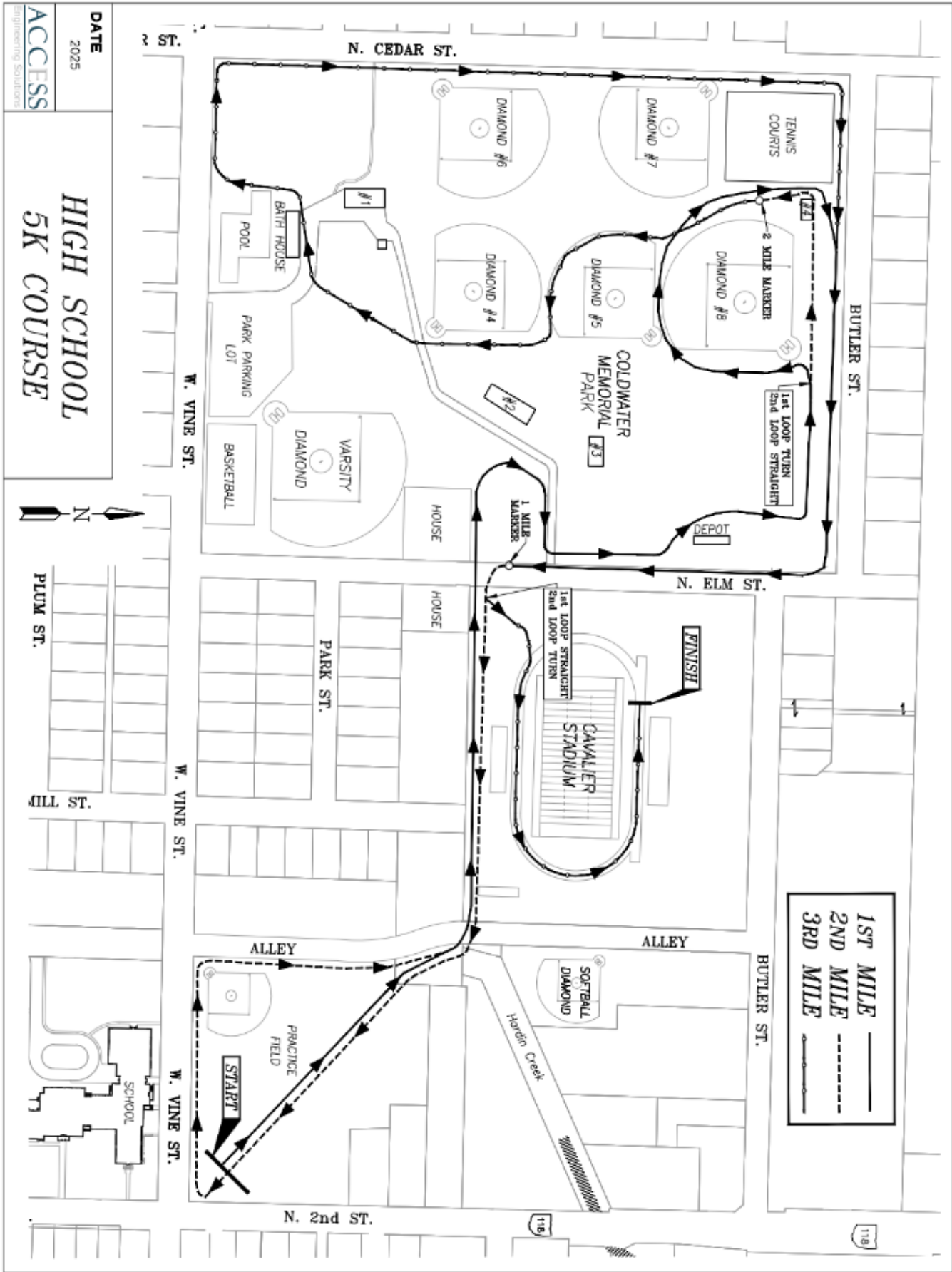

Troy's Story

"At the beginning of August, Troy was your typical boy - getting things ready to show his goats at the Mercer Fair and riding his dirt bike and 4-wheelers, soaking in the last of summer. On August 10, Troy began having headaches, which led to an ER visit discovering a mass on his cerebellum. On August 13, Troy had the tumor removed at Dayton Children's. He proved what a fighter he is - only 3 1/2 days after surgery he was released from the hospital to continue Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy back home at Mercer Health. Then, on August 23, we received the news that Troy's tumor was cancerous.

Because of this diagnosis, Medulloblastoma - subtype Sonic Hedgehog - Troy will undergo about 6 weeks of radiation (tentatively beginning Sept. 15) at Cincinnati Children's, followed by chemotherapy at Dayton Children's for 48 weeks after a 4-week healing break from radiation. Despite all this, Troy is already looking ahead - he hopes to play baseball again next summer and show his goats at the Mercer County Fair in 2026!"
