

CHEYENNE WELLS "TIGERS INVITATIONAL" TRACK MEET

State Qualifying Meet

The Tiger Invitational Track meet will be held on Saturday, April 18, 2026. This meet is a state qualifying event and is sanctioned by CHSAA. **It will be held in Cheyenne Wells.**

CHSAA MEET OFFICIAL'S (CTFOA)

We will be taking entries electronically for this meet. Please go to co.milesplit.com to update your roster and events. Each school will be allowed 3 entries in individual events and one relay team per school per race individuals will be allowed to enter no more than 4 events each. The deadline for all entries is April 16 at noon.

Scratches for the meet may be done at 8:30 a.m. on the day of the meet; the coaches meeting will begin at 8:30 a.m. in the cafeteria. (Walk through the double doors of the north side of the school. No additions please.

- An entry fee of \$175.00 per team will be charged: \$350.00 if you enter both a boys and girls team. If you have less than 10 athletes participating the fee is \$20.00 per athlete.

We will be running finals only for all field and running events. No prelims.

FIELD EVENTS

Field events will begin at 9:00 a.m. Please remind your athletes that they are not to warm up until I have declared the meet open. Field events must be supervised at all times per new CHSAA ruling.

Cheyenne Wells School will provide all discus and shot put. The shot put and discus areas are located up on the football field. Jumping areas are rubberized and are located on the west side of the track. **Cheyenne Wells High School will allow ONLY 1/4 pyramid spikes or 3/16" pyramid spikes or flats on the track and jumping surfaces. Please make sure your athletes have the correct spikes to run on our new track surface.**

We will have 3/16" pyramids spikes available for the athletes to purchase for \$1.00. The athletes will also have their spikes checked to make sure they are the correct length.

Field events will allow 4 attempts. We will measure the athletes first jump/throw then after that they need to make minimum distances as follows:

	<u>Boys</u>	<u>Girls</u>
High Jump	5'	4'
Shot Put	25'	20'
Discus	80'	60'
Long Jump	12' (South pit)	10' (North pit)
Triple Jump	24' (South pit)	22' (North pit)

We will not offer Pole Vault at the Tiger Invitational.

RUNNING EVENTS

Running events will begin around 9:00 a.m. The athletes must check in on the north side of the track by the black/white shed. We will run on an 8-lane track.

AWARDS

Medals will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in all events and ribbons will be given to 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th places. The team scoring will be as follows: 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1 point.

A plaque will be given each to the 1st place girls' team and the 1st place boys' team.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Athletes will not be allowed on the football field during the track meet, except for those that are participating in the jumping and warming up for their next event. There are areas for camps around the track. Please have your teams clean their area before leaving.

A full concession stand will be available. Lunch will be provided for all workers, coaches, administrators, and bus drivers. You will receive a ticket during the coaches meeting to be presented at the concession stand for your meal.

Parking is available on the east side of the school. Please don't park by the helicopter exit.

Restrooms are located on the west side of the track.
