

# **21st ANNUAL HARRY J. HAYES INVITATIONAL SATURDAY. APRIL 11, 2026**



Coaches,

On behalf of Bloomfield High School, we extend to you and your team a sincere invitation to participate in our 21st Annual Harry J. Hayes Invitational. This event is a NM state qualifying track meet. The following will provide you information for the track meet.

## **Facilities**

Bobcat Stadium ( E Pine Ave or E Oak Street - off 520 North 1st Street - Hwy 550 )

Bloomfield High School ( 520 North 1st Street )

Curtis Clement Memorial Track ( 8 lanes - 2 high jump mats-south apron - 4 long jump pits-north end )  
( 2 triple jump pits on NE side of track - pole vault on SE side of track )

Throwing Facility ( located on east side of track - 2 discus rings - 2 shot put rings - javelin runway )

## **Entries**

\* Entries are to be submitted on MileSplit ( [nm.milesplit.com](http://nm.milesplit.com) ) Due on Thursday , April 9 by Midnight.

\* Teams can have 10 entries for each individual event and one relay team.

\* Teams may enter a non-scoring relay team to run in a separate heat (subject to change if not enough teams enter)

\* Athletes may participate in (5) events or less. An athlete may participate in only (4) running events or less and may participate in only (4) field events or less.

## **Entry Fee**

**\$100.00 per school ( covers boys and girls )**

## **Coaches Meeting**

Starts at 8:15 am in the stadium building located south of the track near the finish line. This meeting will cover general information - scratches. Please be on time.

## **Implement Weigh-In**

Starts at 8:00am - Closes at 8:30am ( located in front of bleachers near the finish line )

Javelins-Shot Puts-Discus that do not make weight or pass the inspection will be kept until the throwing events are completed.

## **Field Events**

\* Preliminaries: (3) Throws - (3) Jumps Finals: Top 8 will advance and receive (3) more Throws - Jumps

\* All legal attempts will be measured beyond the minimum marks and posted at the press box.

\* As per NFHS...Warm-ups shall not be allowed unless supervised by an event official or the contestant's coach and only when the venue is declared open for warm-up/competition.

\* Coaches must have their pole vaulters weight verified and poles inspected before competition by the event judge or meet referee.

\* Competitors excused to participate in another event must return within the designated time limit.

## Running Events

- \* Running events will be Finals Only.
- \* 100-200-400-100H-110-300H will be heated slowest to fastest.
- \* 800-1600-3200 if ran in two or more heats- the first heat will be the fast heat.
- \* Heat sheets will be posted on tables near the starting lines. Athletes are responsible for lining up in their assigned lane at the start of each race. Clerk of the Course will help assist runners to proper lanes.

## Awards-Scoring

- \* Plaques will be given to the 1st and 2nd place teams per division.
- \* Medals awarded 1st - 3rd place per event.
- \* Most Valuable Performer Awards (Girl-Boy) based from performance chart.
- \* Scoring: Relays 10-8-6-4-2-1, Individual Events 7-5-4-3-2-1

## Miscellaneous Information

- \* Starting Blocks will be provided.
- \* Only 1/4" spikes or shorter to be used on track and runway surfaces.
- \* No camps on the infield turf - Teams may set up camps and tents on the bleachers.
- \* No food on the infield turf . Please help police your team's area in the bleachers throughout the meet.
- \* Coaches and athletes that are warming up for competition are only allowed on the football field, coaches please help keep athletes not competing and spectators off the field during running events.
