

Welcome to the *Clovis Wildcat Relays*

Dear Coaches,

Clovis High School will be hosting our annual **WILDCAT RELAYS** on Thursday, **April 17, 2026**. The scratch meeting will be at 1:00 pm in the film room. Field Events will begin at 2:00 pm and the running events will begin at 3:00 p.m. We will weigh in all throwing implements starting at 1:00 in the storage barn near the track.

There will be **2 Divisions, Varsity Boys and Varsity Girls**. You may enter **3 athletes per event and 1 relay per team**. Clovis will be running the JV group against the Varsity teams as a separate team, and at this time, this will be the only JV team that will be allowed to compete at the meet. Log on to Mile Split to enter your athletes. This will open on the 10th of April. The deadline for entries is Thursday, April 16th at 5:00 PM. We will **scratch only** at the time of the meet.

There will be no team camps on the football field, these need to be placed in the East Bleachers of the football field, and we will not allow any music to be played by athletes in the stands or on the field. Warmups are allowed on the football field so please ask you athletes who are not warming up to go to the bleachers and not congregate and hang out on the field to congest this area. We also ask that your athletes DO NOT use tape of any kind on the track or runways surfaces. Tape permitted on concrete only. There will be a concession stand available on the west side.

We are providing a meal for our coaches and workers beginning at 4:30 and ending at 6:30. We have given out tickets in the past for your coaching staff and your bus driver at the scratch meeting. New administration may have a different plan, I will let you know. Just in case, I need to know the number of coaches and workers associated with your boys and girls teams as soon as you can get this information to me. Please email me at:

GENERAL INFORMATION

* Field events will consist of 3 attempts with finals. **THERE WILL BE MINIMUMS ON ALL FIELD EVENTS.**

* Only officials and contestants will be allowed on the track infield.

* Scoring will be 7-5-4-3-2-1 in individual events and 10-8-6-4-2-1 in relays.

* Trophies will be awarded for 1st and 2nd place teams. Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.

* **Medals will be given out immediately following each running event.** If you or your athletes think they possibly were in the top 3 finishers, please stay near the awards stand till the announcement of winners is made. All field event medals will be given out during the running events and beginning with the 800 meters. The top 3 finishers will need to be near our awards stand when the 800-meter run begins.

* Short spikes $\frac{1}{4}$ inch or flats will be required of all contestants. Starting blocks will be furnished.

***THERE IS TO BE NO TAPE OR CHALK USED ON ANY RUNNING SURFACE AS IT IS NEW. TENNIS BALLS OR SOME OTHER NON ADHESIVE MARKER THAT CAN BE EASILY BE PICKED UP NEEDS TO BE USED (EX. SMALL CONES, FLAT RUBBER MARKERS).** The running track, pole vault, long jump and high jump area are all-weather surfaces. THESE ARE THE AREAS I AM TALKING ABOUT.

*** *Long jump and triple jump events will each conclude 90 minutes after they begin regardless of if a contestant has completed all their final jumps. If a contestant must go run they need to check with the official at the event to take a series of attempts in an effort to conclude their participation. If they check out of an event and the official has concluded the event the event is considered over regardless of whether or not the athlete has completed all their jumps.***

* Running events will have precedence over the field events. Runners must return within 10 minutes of the conclusion of their race.

* Participants are requested not to wear spikes in the metal bleacher area.

* Contestants will be limited to events as outlined in the New Mexico Activities Association's Handbook.

* **In heated races, we will not have heat leaders and the first heat is the FAST heat.**

PARTICIPATION LIMITATIONS:

A contestant may enter a maximum of five events, but no more than four may be running events, not more than four may be field events. No more than three of the four races can be 400 meters or longer.

The Clovis Municipal School District appreciates your participation in this meet.

Field Events: 3 attempts, top 8 to finals, 3 more attempts.

Minimum Distances/Starting Heights: If your athlete cannot attain these marks you may consider not entering them into this competition. We will NOT tape a board on the long jump/triple jump runways.

All markers must be removable, like a tennis ball. No tape on the runway surface or the turf. It is all new and is at the request of the AD and facilities management.

Hip and Chest Stickers:

Only required for the 800, 1600, and 3200 in opens. All relays, the final leg needs stickers. Laned races should not need a hip sticker. Trying to cut down on a massive hip sticker line. Please communicate this to your athletes.

Running Events:

Sprints are heated fast to slow.

Distance races (1600 and up) will not be broken up into multiple heats. 1 heat only.

4x800 will be one heat for boys and one heat for girls.

Results:

Will be posted on MileSplit on Friday night after the track meet. A printed copy can be provided to you if you would like one. You must visit the press box to pick one up.

Awards:

Will be presented at the awards stand at the conclusion of the Boys 4x400 Relay. Medals will be handed out immediately after each event on the track. Field events will begin distribution during the 4x200 Relay.

Throwers Relay (4x100) will be included in our format for the Wildcat Relays. This is for the kids on your team that are *strictly throwers*, not for one of your kids who regularly runs and happens to throw as well. THERE IS ALSO A WEIGHT MINIMUM OF 200 POUNDS FOR THE BOYS, ANY LESS AND THE THROWER IS NOT ALLOWED. GIVE THE HUSKY BOYS A CHANCE. FOR THE GIRLS I AM NOT ASKING THAT QUESTION. This relay will be run prior to the 4x400 meter relay. There will be no more than ONE heat per division). ***This relay will not count towards the team score and no medals will be given for this race.*** The winning team (only) from each division will be announced and honored at the awards stand at the conclusion of the race. You will need to email me if you are interested in competing. There will be no more than **ONE** heat per division. The first 6 visiting teams to register for this event will be included (we have 8 lanes, but you know **WE** are going to be running in it!) until the cutoff is met. It's fun! (Weather permitting)
