Facility Information	We have an 8-lane all weather track, with all weather surfaces in the field event areas as well. Please use ¼ inch spikes only. Teams will need to supply their own batons for relay events. Tennis balls will be provided for relays.
Coaches Meeting	Coaches meeting will take place at 3:30pm in the Hospitality room.
Bus Drop off/Parking	Bus drop off will be at the main gate. Bus parking will at lot across from Maplewood Elementary on the corner of Monroe St. and Silica (noted on the campus map)
Hospitality	We will have a hospitality room for coaches and officials, located on the visitors side concession stand near the pole vault areas
Team Camps	Set up outside the fenced track area (see campus map)
Scoring	Scoring for running events (top 6 score): 1st place= 10 points 2nd place= 8 points 3rd place= 6 points 4th place= 4 points 5th place= 2 points 6th place= 1 points Scoring for field events (top 8 score) 1st place= 10 points 2nd place= 8 points 3rd place= 6 points 4th place= 5 points 5th place= 4 points 6th place= 3 points 7th place= 2 points 8th place= 1 point
Awards	The top two finishers in each event will receive a t-shirt. The winning boys and girls teams for the meet will be recognized with a plaque.
Athletic Training	The Northview athletic training team will be on site the day of the event.

- OHSAA rules govern all events
- FAT timing used for all running events
- Athletes must report by second call to check-in clerk

Facility Guidelines

- Running shoes, cross-trainers, tennis shoes, and 1/4" pyramid spikes are the only footwear permitted
- No motorized vehicles, carts, skateboards, bikes, or rollerblades allowed
- No pets
- No food, drinks (other than water)
