

State Championship Meet Information

Congrats on making it to State! Below, you will find some pertinent information to ensure the meet runs smoothly. Please read carefully and don't hesitate to reach out with any questions.

Campsites & Warmup Areas:

Tents and campsites will not be allowed inside of the stadium. Campsites can be set up in the large field directly behind the tennis courts. There will be a PA system down at the campsite area to support clerking and announce event calls.

Athletes should not warm up on the infield. A designated warm up area is available near the clerking station, on the grass patch East of the tennis courts.

Stadium Entry/Exit:

Stadium entry and exit for coaches and athletes will take place through the large gate on the south end of the stadium. All participating athletes will need to have uniform for entry. Coaches will need their district provided badge.

Event Clerking:

All athletes will need to check in to their event, grab hip stickers, and turn in relay cards at the clerking tent to the East of the tennis courts. Following the third call, all athletes participating in the event will be escorted up to the stadium in their heat or flight and brought to their event start point.

Coaches Hospitality:

A hospitality room will be set up in the weight room. Snacks and water will be available throughout both days. A catered lunch will be provided on Saturday and should arrive around 11:30am.

Coaches Boxes:

Coaching boxes will be strictly enforced at each field event and are located along gates OUTSIDE of the track. These areas can be observed at each event with colored pennant flags. Please ensure that you are staying in the coaches' box while providing feedback to athletes.

General Reminders:

The infield area is completely closed off to all coaches and athletes not participating in an event for safety purposes related to discus. Coaches should stay outside the gates in

coaching boxes and athletes should use designated areas to warm up. Please remind athletes not to bring any electronics onto the infield. Any electronic usage may result in disqualification from all events the athlete is participating in.

Volunteers and officials are present to help ensure the meet runs smoothly. Please be kind to them. Any behavior deemed to be aggressive, harassing, offensive, or disruptive to any official, volunteer, or athlete may result in disqualification from event/meet for athletes, or ejection from meet for coaches. Please ensure you are setting a positive example for those around you.
